### Mandaree Celebration

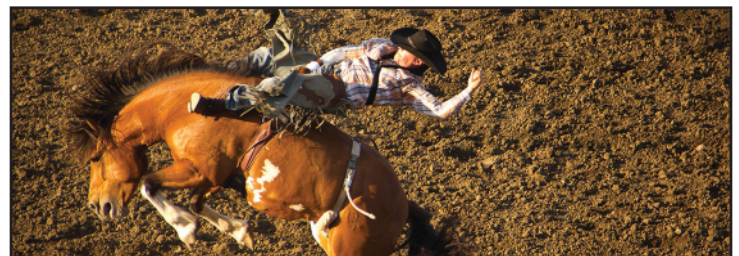
July 18-22, 2019, Mandaree
